SWIPE is a service of Civic Digits C.I.C

Welcome!

We've drafted these Terms of Service (which we call the "Terms") so you'll know the rules that govern our relationship with you. Although we have tried our best to make it all make as much sense as possible, sometimes it's really hard to do that. There are places where these Terms may still seem like they've been deliberately written in a particularly difficult language. We're really really sorry about that. However, these Terms do form a legally binding contract between you and SWIPE. So please read them carefully.

By using SWIPE or any of our other products or services that link to these Terms (we refer to these simply as the "Services"), you agree to the Terms. Of course, if you don't agree with them, then don't use the Services.
